



2016 Summer Korean Internship Application

The Korean language program at the University of Georgia provides UGA students with an opportunity to work as interns in a Korean high school or a college during the summer of 2016. It is a one-month unpaid internship with free board and lodging. Information about applying for the 2016 internship is shown below.

Institution

- Daegeon High School (Nonsan)
- Tongmyong University (Busan)

** Students will be assigned to either Daegeon High School or Tongmyong University depending on the availability of intern positions at each school. The majority of interns will be assigned to Daegeon High School, as Tongmyong University offers only a limited number of seats. Selected applicants will be notified of their assigned schools in February, 2016.*

Period & Date

- 4 weeks in July 2016 (subject to change)

Duties

- English teaching, administrative work, leading extracurricular activities, etc.

Application Timeline

- Application open: 1.11.2016 (M)
- Application close: 1.31.2016 (S)
- Announcement of Decisions: 2.8.2016 (M)

Application Process

An applicant must submit an application form to casuga@uga.edu in addition to a non-refundable application fee of \$15. The application form will be available for download via the Korean language program section on the comparative literature website (<http://www.cmlt.uga.edu/korean-language-and-literature>) and the Center for Asian Studies website (<http://asianstudies.uga.edu>). The application fee may be paid in person at the Korean language program office (136 Joe Brown Hall). Selected applicants must make a deposit of \$200. The deposit will cover expenses for domestic trips organized by the schools.

** Participants are responsible for their own airfare and other travel expenses. They may be supported by external financial resources such as the UGA Freeman-ASIA Scholarship (<http://www.iie.org/programs/freeman-asia>).*

** In the selection process, priority will be given to those students who have declared or are considering pursuing a Korean minor.*
