



2017 Summer Korean Internship Application

The Korean language program at the University of Georgia provides UGA students with an opportunity to work as interns in a Korean high school during the summer of 2017. It is a one-month unpaid internship with free board and lodging. Information about applying for the 2017 internship is shown below.

Duties

- English teaching, administrative work, leading extracurricular activities, etc.

- Announcement of Decisions: 02.01.2017

Application Process

An applicant must submit an application form to casuga@uga.edu in addition to a non-refundable application fee of \$15. The application form will be available for download via the Korean language program section on the comparative literature website (<http://www.cmlt.uga.edu/korean-language-and-literature>) and the Center for Asian Studies website (<http://asianstudies.uga.edu>). The application fee may be paid in person at the Korean language program office (136 Joe Brown Hall). Selected applicants must make a deposit of \$200. The deposit will cover expenses for domestic trips organized by the schools.

* Participants are responsible for their own airfare and other travel expenses. They may be supported by external financial resources such as the UGA Freeman-ASIA Scholarship (<http://www.iie.org/programs/freeman-asia>) and OIE Asia-Georgia Internship Connection Scholarship (<https://goabroad.uga.edu/index.cfm?FuseAction=Programs.ListAll&type=3>).

* In the selection process, priority will be given to those students who have declared or are considering pursuing a Korean major or minor.
